Refurbished in recent years, yet still echoing its timeless history stretching back to the Norman times, Mercure Box Hill Burford Bridge Hotel is set in the stunning North Downs.

Originally founded as 'The Fox and Hounds' in 1254, with parts of the surviving building dating back to the 16th century, the hotel boasts an incredible depth of history. The name was changed to 'The Hare and Hounds' in 1822, and then to its current title in 1905.

The stunning countryside surrounding the hotel has inspired peacefulness and creativity in many visitors over the centuries, notably Queen Victoria, Jane Austen, William Wordsworth and John Keats, who completed his 1817 epic *Endymion* during his stay.

In 1801 Lord Nelson and Lady Hamilton visited the hotel, just a few years before Nelson sailed to his heroic death at the Battle of Trafalgar. The Lady Hamilton Room commemorates this today.

The 16th-century Tithe Barn was re-erected and joined the hotel in 1934, and nowadays is used as a gorgeous wedding venue.

Explore some wonderful historic local attractions only a short drive away including Box Hill National Trust, Polesden Lacey and Denbies Wine Estate. Or relax and experience the heated outdoor pool, open from May to September, with alfresco dining also available in our stunning landscaped gardens.

DID YOU KNOW?

The word 'soup' is believed to have come from either the Middle English word *soupen* which meant to sip or from Latin *suppa*, which was 'sopped' bread or bread that is dipped in broth.

The word 'piccalilli' is thought to have been introduced in the middle of the 18th century, possibly a blend of *pickle* and *chilli*, and inspired by Indian cuisine. Piccalilli is a mixture of chopped vegetables and hot spices, including turmeric which gives its distinctive colour.
